


Trackbox

New filter & Board view




Before the changes, we had...

In 2022, Trackbox introduced a new brand for the iGaming industry



On the other hand...

A decision was made to align Trackbox existing system with the new design, updating features and improving infrastructure.



Users pain points & needs

We gave our focus group (6-8 users) a test to observe how they use it daily.



The number of clicks for the search was high



The filter row takes up **too much space**



Inability to **Compare**



Users **cannot see** the filter **parameters** immediately



Users didn't see how to **collapse** the filter row


The goal is to simplify the filtering process, making it faster and customizable.

Copying – it's easy, but not very smart

There were also several issues here




The filter was **split** into multiple topics (dates, pivot). Also, the filter's **summaries** on the screen caused distractions.





It was very difficult to filter and understand what was filtered.





Inability to **Compare**




Dont show applied filters

Filter out the noise, and let the good results shine!


Collapse filter

We kept the collapse filter design and added a refresh button next to it





Floating modal & Pin option
















Content is open by default

We reduced clicks by making all filter content open by default




Advanced filter

Visualize your board's information order




Fixed **column layout**, and table appearance



Create a permanent filter


The challenge -> visible but not distracting

We added the feature without cluttering the screen, using a neutral color scheme to keep it clean.




Create "View" quickly

Quickly add a new board view to compare




Easy editing
